## Are we saved by Grace or by Works?

Eph. 2:4-9

4 But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us,

6 And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:

8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

I should stop right here, but I fear that if I did, many would still not understand the simplicity that is the Gospel of Jesus Christ and that is found in this Scripture.

I have read in the Gospels, how Jesus was accused of eating with sinners. The funny thing was, He ALWAYS ATE WITH SINNERS! He was the ONLY one without sin! It seems one of the biggest problems in the church world today, is that we forget that all sin is sin. We look at someone else's sin and say, he is a sinner. We don't see our own sin! The religious leaders who accused Jesus of eating with sinners, were themselves sinners! They just didn't know it! They bought into one of the oldest lies that has ever been given to man.
