2022 Minister's Conference


MONDAY, OCTOBER 10th to FRIDAY, OCTOBER 14th, 2022

DURING THE FLOODING

The problem with living in West Texas is when it rains, it pours. The road down to Cheryl's would often flood and stay that way for days or even weeks during the rainy season. Last year we were considering options to rent equipment and try to address the problem, but the Lord in His grace and provision had another option. A contractor contacted us about the need for material to repair some of the southernmost pipeline road. In short, we gave them access to our small stock pond for fill material which saved them thousands of dollars. In exchange, they made massive improvements to our roads and installed two culvert pipes down near the driveway to my range to manage overflow from the small stock pond. The main road was raised by several inches and has all but eliminated the flooding and standing water, at least for the normal rains that we get.

In late August we had our first real test of these new improvements. We were hit with the worst flooding that I've seen since I've been here, and it overwhelmed the stock ponds and all our water management efforts. Within a couple of hours, we had a river going past the orchard as well as the spillway east of the new small stock pond by Sue's office. It was dumping a torrent of water into the driveway to the range that was about 18" deep. The rain came in surges and eventually the water rose to the point of coming into the range building. While all this sounds pretty bad, there was a huge silver lining.

While we had a massive amount of water come through, the work that had been done meant that it shed off very quickly. By midafternoon, the range was clear and

by evening the road was clear. There was minimal damage to my range building, everything is up off the ground in the range building just on case of such an event, and there was no real damage or loss anywhere on the property.

The photos and videos that I took were pretty dramatic. I plan to finish editing the video at some point and will share them with you all. Sue's included a few photos here for you all to see. It was a pretty amazing day.

Now that we've had all this rain, the entire desert has come alive. This is the greenest that I've seen and it's absolutely beautiful. Here are a couple of really nice photos we hope you all enjoy.

Africa News



As many of you know, our Ghanaian Brother Lawrence Tsimese is the head of our African outreach. For the past 13 years he has been faithfully ministering daily from his base in Tema, Ghana. Manifesting the truth of the Gospel through his life that is wholly dedicated to the Lord, Brother Lawrence ministers through a combination of business engagement, discipleship of ministers, children trained up in the way they should go as well as regular preaching and teaching engagements.

Over the years, Brother Charles Hocker and Brother Steve Atherton have visited with him in Ghana in demonstration of our support for his ministry. Brother Lawrence has also traveled to Sierra Leone and Kenya in connection with his outreach to local African churches throughout the continent.

Following close on the heels of Brother Steve's 9-week trip to Ghana in 2021, the Lord has been further expanding opportunities for Brother Lawrence. Recently, two long-time Ghanaian Ministers and a third from Uganda have entered into discipleship with Brother Lawrence. Such developments align perfectly with our goal of strengthening ministers of the Gospel throughout Africa rather than establishing churches ourselves.

When a Ghanaian University President suggested to Brother Steve that he establish a church in Ghana, Brother Steve asked him: "Why would I do that? Have not you received something of the Lord from me?"

"Well yes" replied the startled President.

"If you will simply share that which you have received from the Lord with everyone you know, then what need is there for me to establish a church here?" asked Brother Steve. "Everyone you know can receive the same thing from the Lord that you did. They do not need me."

Coming up shortly, Brother Steve, Sister Megan and their four children will be leaving for Sister Megan's native country of South Africa, where they plan to reside until the middle of May 2023. This will be our fellowship's third trip to South Africa, building upon a previous visit by Brother Steve and Sister Megan as well as the more recent visit paid by Sister Robin to our South African Sister Joan Clinning. With great anticipation, we look forward to seeing what the Lord does in South Africa.

Please keep Brother Lawrence, Brother Steve, Sister Megan and their families, friends and fellow laborers in prayer. The hope is that Brother Lawrence will be able to join them in South Africa for at least a brief time. THE GREAT COMMISSION

Everyone knows the "Great Commission". It was succinctly set forth by Christ and recorded in Mark Chapter 16:

- 15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.
- 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Sadly, most people see it as unattainable because they believe they have to travel the world and speak the name of Jesus or quote the Word of God to people in order to fulfill it. In truth, the command is for us to "preach the Gospel" (when necessary using words as Brother Davy repeatedly said) as we operate in the world, rather than having to travel around the world. In other words, Christ is talking about those other 6 days of the week when you are "in the world" but not "of the world."

Over the years I have learned that the key to fulfilling the Great Commission is to simply walk in the "love of God" towards all people in your everyday life. In my experience, this generally does not involve speaking the name of Jesus, inviting folks to church or asking them if they are saved. Instead, if you prayerfully seek the Lord for others, He will move through you in accordance with your prayers to minister "the oracles of God" (as Peter described it in I Peter 4:11) unto them. It is through that fitly spoken word or action, coupled with a peculiar life testifying of God's workmanship (not man's), that the victory of the Gospel of Jesus Christ is made manifest in the world. As you walk that out, the Lord working with you by His

power to confirm His Word, you will evidently set forth the truth of the Gospel amongst those you interact with in your daily life, whether that be at work, at home or while out and about. Then, when people ask a reason for the hope that is in you, you will be able to speak the Gospel in a credible manner that moves people to embrace Christ's salvation for themselves.
